Bible Study - 10 Lepers Cleansed - Luke 17:11-10

Read Luke 17:11-10. Work through the questions below, either on your own or with a friend/family member.

What do we learn about the men from Luke's account?

Reflect on their entreaty to Jesus (vs 12-13). What stands out? What do you think they were hoping to receive from Him that day?

How does Jesus heal them (vs 14)? Why is this significant? What lesson might we take from this?

Read Leviticus 14:1-32. Reflect on the cleansing rites required by the Law for these men. What stands out to you?

Reflect on the return of the Samaritan (vs 15-16). What does he do? Why is this significant? What example do we need to take from him?

Reflect on Jesus' reaction to the Samaritan's return (vs 17-18). Why does Jesus raise these questions? What lesson/s is in them for His disciples then and for us today? What does it take to be more like the Samaritan than the other nine who were healed that day?

Luke is the only Gospel to record this particular miracle. Why do you think he felt it needed to be included in his Gospel account?

According to verse 19, what made the Samaritan well (whole)? What was the lesson to the crowd in this declaration about the man?

This is the last recorded miracle before Jesus' death. Why was it important? What special messages were Jesus' disciples (past and present) to take from it?

What primary lesson will you take from this healing account?
